Every year, thousands of survivors of torture, trafficking, sexual violence, and other human rights abuses seek asylum in the UK. Many endure chronic physical pain and severely debilitating psychological symptoms including depression, PTSD, and suicidal thoughts.

Most survivors will interact, often repeatedly, with GPs and A&E in the UK. Yet the vast majority are never asked about the abuses they have suffered.

When harm is not recognised, it is not recorded. No record means poor healthcare and missed opportunities to provide support and ensure safety. TortureID exists to change this.
