

Demographic data of referrals for Health Assessment, Q2 2026

During the second quarter of 2026, TortureID offered 29 health assessment appointments. At the time of writing, one referral was under review, while a second has been cancelled.

Appointments were offered across all projects:

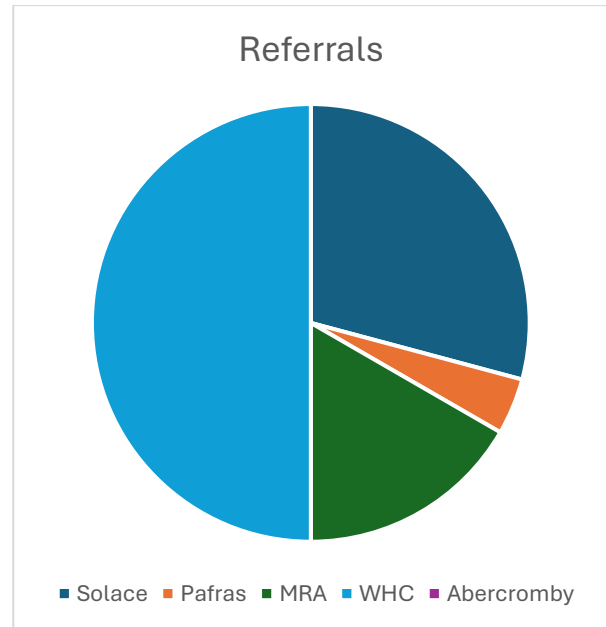
Solace: 7

Abercromby: 5



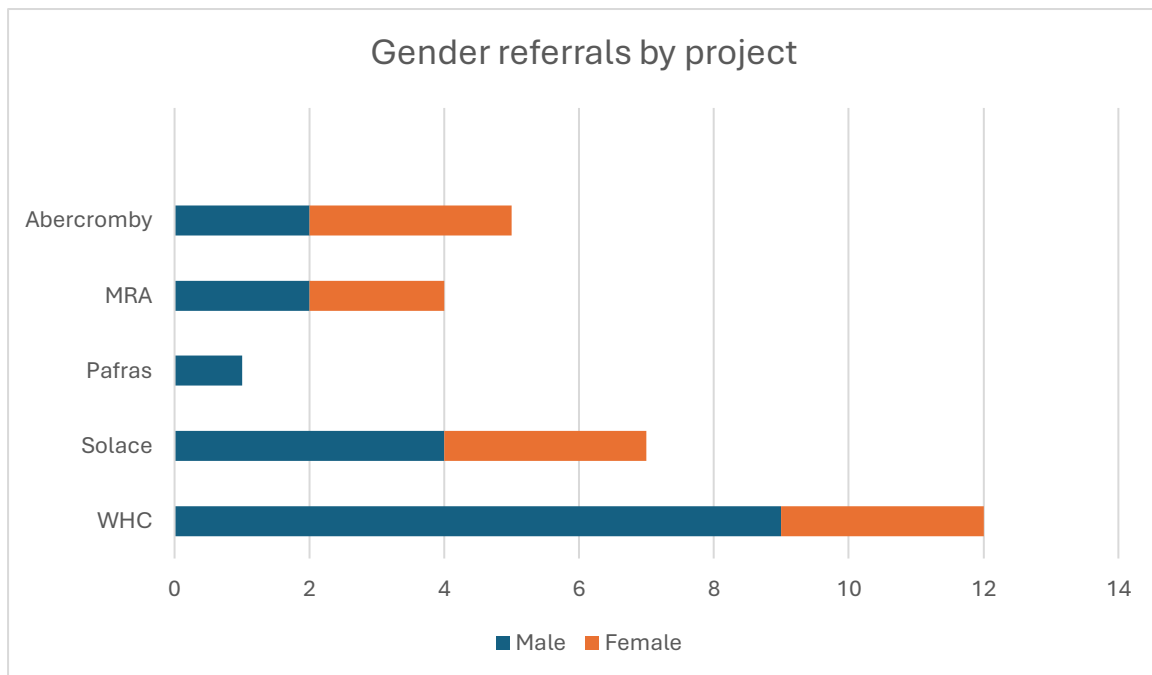
